


How to search e-Discover : a brief introduction




is the CTF's portal to electronic books and databases. It includes all the CTF's e-titles, but also links to useful text on the Common Awards Hub, the Internet Archive and other sources.

If you know the author and title of the book you require, just put a simple search term into the search box on the front page. If you are looking for Victoria Raymer's *The Bible in Worship*, for example, simply enter 'raymer' in the search box and press Return on your keyboard:



This will take you to the results list. In this case there is 1 result. Now click on the title (in blue):



This takes you to the item record for the ebook. Click on the title and you will be taken to the ebook:




Offering a truly holistic study of the scripture in worship, the book will resource readers to reflect on how proclamation invites response in understanding and resolve, and to consider how it might do so more effectively.



Sometimes, a search will provide multiple results. If for example you search for the author 'Brueggemann', for example you will get 34 results.

As with all database results screens, you may need to scroll down to see all the results, which are displayed 10 to a page:



Sometimes, when you get to the item screen, you will see a link next to 'Log-in instructions'. This means that e-Discover is pointing you to another source where you may need to login. These links point to pages telling you how to do that.

Here is an example. If I search for Brueggemann's *The prophetic imagination* and follow the link to the item page, the record includes a link that says: 'Logging into the Internet Archive'. If I follow this link I reach a page telling me how to do that: see the examples below:



You can also search for subjects on e-Discover. Again, just put your subject into the search box and change the 'Sort by' box to 'Subject'. Return on your keyboard. In this example, the search term is 'Worship' and there are 57 items, which once again appear as a list:
